Length & Circumference Measurements

Take length measurements first. If possible, use a skin marker to mark the measurement points on the limb. All length measurements up to **g** should be taken straight with the patient lying or sitting.

The arm should be well supported with the palm facing up if possible. Take the measurements on the inside of the arm as far as possible. Identify on the form if the arm is measured in a different position.


